## Carrier Corp. Dedicates New Library at ASHRAE Headquarters

ATLANTA, Nov. 6, 2008 – On Oct 23, Carrier Corp., a unit of United Technologies Corp. (NYSE:UTX), dedicated the Willis H. Carrier Engineering Library at the headquarters for the American Society of Heating, Refrigerating and Air-Conditioning Engineers (ASHRAE) with a formal ribbon-cutting ceremony. Additionally, Automated Logic Corp., a subsidiary of Carrier, donated its Web CTRL® networked building automation system to provide a user interface for ASHRAE’s living lab, allowing researchers around the world to monitor its performance and extract data.
