Carrier Corp. Donates to China Disaster Relief

SHANGHAI, China, June 6, 2008 – Carrier Corp.’s Building Systems and Services Asia division has pledged its support for the China earthquake relief effort by making a \$10,000 donation to the China Red Cross.
