## Installation Instructions


**IMPORTANT:** Read these instructions completely before attempting to install the accessory outdoor coil grille.

### SAFETY CONSIDERATIONS

Installation and servicing of air-conditioning equipment can be hazardous due to system pressure and electrical components. Only trained and qualified service personnel should install, repair, or service air-conditioning equipment.

Untrained personnel can perform the basic maintenance functions. All other operations should be performed by trained service personnel. When working on air-conditioning equipment, observe precautions in the literature, tags and labels attached to the unit, and other safety precautions that may apply.

Follow all safety codes. Wear safety glasses and work gloves.

Recognize safety information. This is the safety-alert symbol . When you see this symbol on the unit and in instructions or manuals, be alert to the potential for personal injury.

Understand the signal words DANGER, WARNING, and CAUTION. These words are used with the safety-alert symbol. DANGER identifies the most serious hazards which **will** result in severe personal injury or death. WARNING signifies a hazard which **could** result in personal injury or death. CAUTION is used to identify unsafe practices which **may** result in minor personal injury or product and property damage. NOTE is used to highlight suggestions which **will** result in enhanced installation, reliability, or operation.

### WARNING

#### ELECTRICAL SHOCK HAZARD

Failure to follow this warning could cause personal injury or death.

Before beginning any modification on unit, always turn off main power switch to unit and install lockout tag. Unit may have more than one power switch.

### CAUTION

#### CUT HAZARD

Failure to follow this caution may result in personal injury. Sheet metal parts may have sharp edges or burrs. Use care and wear appropriate protective clothing, safety glasses and gloves when handling parts and servicing furnaces.

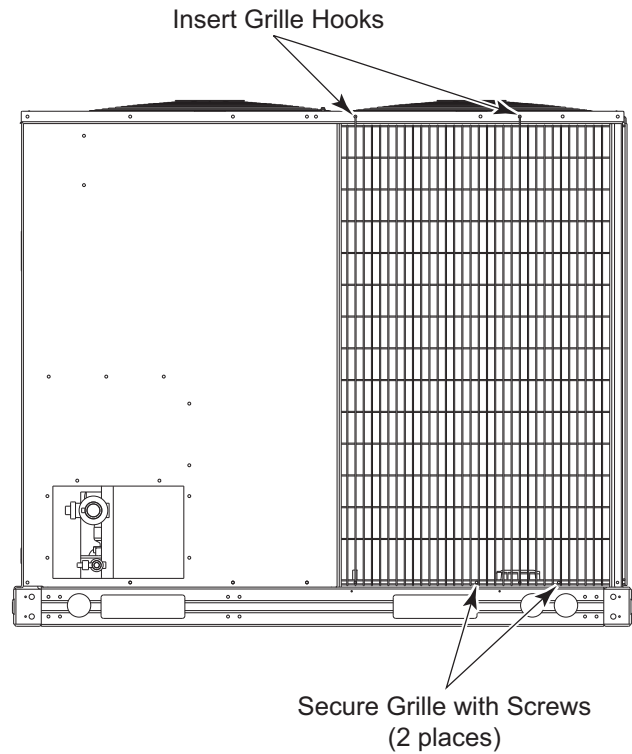

## INSTALLATION

1. Remove outdoor coil grilles from their protective packaging. The 6, 7<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> and 10 ton unit accessories contain 2 grilles. The 12<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> ton unit accessory contains 3 grilles.
2. Insert the hooks at the top of the grille into the holes provided on the top cover of the unit. See Fig. 1, 2, and 3 for locations, depending on the grille currently being attached.
3. Attach the bottom of the grille by checking to see which of the screws in the unit's base pan align with the bottom of the grille. (The basepan is located at the base of the unit and folds over the base rails.) Remove the screw that align with the bottom of the grille.
4. Use the screws removed in step 3 to attach the bottom of the grille to the base pan in those positions. See Fig. 1, 2, and 3 for locations, depending on the grille currently being attached.

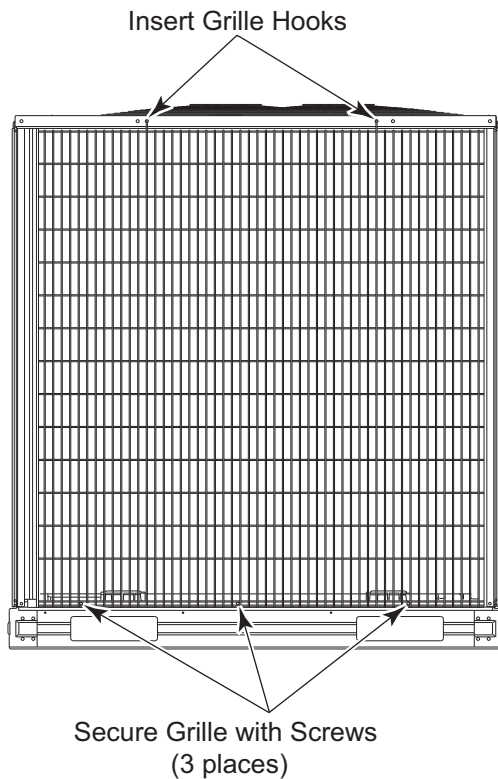
**NOTE:** If there is no screw in the base pan, in the position that aligns with the bottom of the grille, use the screws included with the accessory.

5. Repeat steps 2, 3 and 4 for the remaining grille(s).



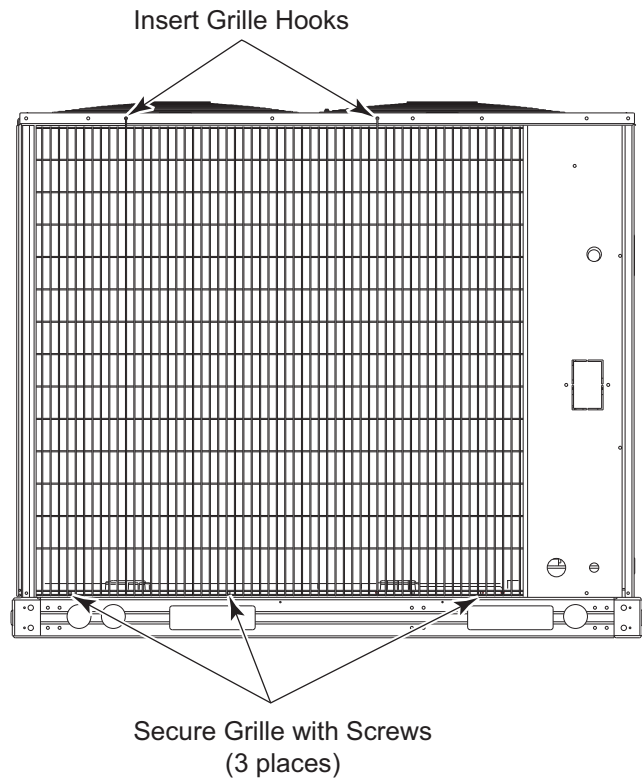
